Tuition fees cover all tuition, including English language classes, as well as basic stationery items. **Administration fees** include enrolment and administration costs.

Pastoral care includes 24/7 pastoral care.

Homestay costs are \$350 per week – these may need to increase in line with cost-of-living increases.

Please <u>contact us</u> for an estimate of the costs for your student or student group.

Additional costs may include:

- Insurance (per annum) \$750 we arrange our insurance through <u>Uni-Care</u>.
- Prepaid expenses/contingency fund (per annum) \$1500 this fund covers specialised stationery, trips, sports and club fees, music lessons and equipment hire. Students involved in several groups or activities may need to top up their fund throughout the year. Any unused portion is refunded at the end of the student's time at our school.
- Government Levy (per annum) \$450 \$120 per term.
- Compulsory camp fee \$400 part of Prepaid expenses/contingency fund.
- Uniform purchase (a one-off cost) \$750 for a new uniform. Students must purchase their own footwear.
- Uniform hire (per term) \$200 a few second-hand items are available please enquire.
- Airport shuttle (per return trip from/to Auckland Airport) \$350 \$450— depending on time of day/night and the location of the homestay.
- External exam fees <u>NCEA</u> (National Certificate of Educational Achievement) fees or other examination fees.
- Homestay placement fee (per enrolment) \$150
- Homestay change fee (per instance) \$150 this additional fee may be charged if a student wishes to change their homestay.
- Leaver's documentation fee \$150
- Pocket money we suggest no more than \$50 a week. We do not hold pocket money for students.

General notes

- All costs are in New Zealand dollars and GST inclusive.
- Per annum costs are adjusted for the time the student is enrolled.
- Intended term dates for 2025 are as follows, but may be subject to change. See https://www.education.govt.nz/school/school-terms-and-holiday-dates/#school-terms2025
- for more details. We recommend that students are available to attend school several days before the official term dates for assessment, orientation and timetable adjustments.
 - Term 1: Monday 27 January to Friday 11 April
 - Term 2: Monday 28 April to Friday 27 June
 - Term 3: Monday 14 July to Friday 19 September
 - Term 4: Monday 6 October to Friday 19 December (likely to be earlier).
- Four-week enrolments are *occasionally* considered and need the Principal's approval. In Terms 3 and 4, short term enrolments are only available for Years 9 and 10 as seniors are preparing for examinations.
- Students enrolled for one term or less may wear their own school uniform so long as it is neat and tidy.
- Subject choices for short-term students may be limited due to class sizes.
- Some parents may wish to have a local Guardian appointed who can interpret when necessary. This is an **additional cost** and **is not a requirement.**
- Payments:
 - The preferred method of payment is by bank transfer. Please reference your student's name and ID number as noted on the invoice.
 - A credit card fee of 2% applies to payments over \$500.
 - We cannot accept cash payments over NZ\$500.
- Please read the terms and conditions in the contract of enrolment.
