Criteria: Significant contribution made to the Catholic Character of the contributing Catholic Primary School or at SHGC.

A Letter of Application must be supported by your Principal or, for current students, by the applicant's CCM Companion.

Academic Scholarships

Four scholarships of \$500 each:

- 2 for new students entering the College (at Year 9)
- · 2 for current students

Criteria: Outstanding academic performance at the contributing Catholic Primary School or College.

A Letter of Application must be supported by your Principal or, for current students, by the applicant's CCM Companion.

Criteria: Outstanding performance in a particular sport demonstrated at the previous school or at SHGC.

There is an expectation that SHGC is the recipient's first choice for sport representation whilst they are enrolled here, unless permission is granted by the Principal for exceptional circumstances.

A Letter of Application must be endorsed by your Principal and your Sports Coach. Or, for current students, by the Director of Sport Development and your Sports Coach.

Application Process

A Letter of Application from the student, and endorsement as outlined is required. Please also provide evidence to support your application: eg certificates, school reports, results etc.
